Building Fund

Next weekend there will be a 2nd collection for the building fund. There are several building maintenance projects underway. We are in the process of getting quotes and are in dialogue with the Archdiocese for approvals (almost \$300k).

- St James - replacement of steam boilers with new heating different system
- St Mary's - new furnace has been installed and converted to propane
- New front doors for St. James
- Repairs to the Church office

There are a number of larger projects being considered based on the recommendations from an engineer and an architect who have prepared building condition reports.
