We are pleased to announce that St. James Parish in Colgan will be hosting a summer camp facilitated by the Office of

Catholic Youth entitled Totus Tuus (which is Latin for "totally yours"). Four lay missionaries will be sent to our parish to facilitate the program.

The day camp for students entering Gr. 1 to Gr. 6 will run from Monday, July 14 through Friday, July 18 from 9:00 am to 2:30 pm. The evening camp for students entering Gr. 7 to 12 will take place from Sunday, July 13 through Thursday, July 17 from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.

Registration is \$90 per child for the day camp and \$50 per child for the evening camp. There will be a special discount for families - \$5 off per each additional child. Registration fees can be paid via debit or credit card, cash, or cheques

made out to "St. James Parish," and dropped off at the parish office. The registration deadline is Fri. July 4. Volunteer opportunities are also available; volunteer screening is required in addition to the completion of a volunteer registration form.
