St. James Summer Camp

St. James Parish is pleased to announce that we will be running our own summer camp this year in place of Totus Tuus summer camp. We will be running our own programming with our own team of missionaries!

From **Monday, July 6 through Friday, July 10, 2026**, from 9 am – 3 pm, there will be an **elementary student camp for students in grades 1 to 8**. The elementary student camp will include crafts, activities, daily Mass, Confession, catechesis, recess, and outdoor fun! The elementary student camp will be similar to our Children's Ministry and Edge programs at the parish.

From **Sunday, July 5 through Thursday, July 9, 2026**, from 4 – 6 pm, there will be a **high school student camp for grades 9 to 12**. The high school student camp will include talks, games, Adoration, Confession, and small group discussions. The high school camp will be similar to our LifeTeen program at the parish.

Registration is \$100 per child for the elementary student camp, and \$40 per person for the high school camp. There will be a special discount of \$5 for each additional child from the same family. **Early bird pricing is only until April 30th**. On May 1st, regular pricing is \$130 for the elementary student camp. There will still be a special discount of \$5 for each additional child from the same family.
