



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

We are pleased to announce a very **special Catholic summer program for youth that is being held at St. James Parish called *Totus Tuus*** (Latin for “totally yours”). **Four fully trained lay missionaries** will be sent to facilitate the camp. **The day camp for Grades 1 to 6 will run from Mon. July 15 through Fri. July 19.** Here is a typical schedule (although there will be **fun and games on Fri. July 19** for the bulk of the day):

The evening program for Grades 7 to 12 will run from Sun. July 14 (evening only) through Thurs. July 18. There will also be a **potluck dinner on Thurs. July 18** from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm. Here is a typical schedule:

6:00 pm	Arrival and Welcome
6:15 pm	Introduction and ice breaker
6:45 pm	Dinner
7:30 pm	Session #1
7:50 pm	Small group discussion
8:10 pm	Session #2 with activity
8:30 pm	Night Prayer
9:00 pm	Dismissal (Note: Thursday ends at 9:30 pm)

How do I register?

Registration packages (including the application form, a waiver form, and a child pickup authorization form) will be available in the sacristy and the parish office. The registration deadline is **Sun. July 7**. Registration fees can be paid via debit or credit card, cash, or cheques made out to “St. James Parish,” and dropped off at the parish office. You can leave the money or cheque in a sealed envelope with your full name in the drop box located on the side of the parish office at St. James. Please also indicate on the envelope that the payment is for Totus Tuus registration.

You can also drop off your payment in person during office hours (Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 2 pm to 5 pm).

If you cannot afford the registration fee, please contact the parish office.

What is the cost of registration?

The registration fee for the day program (Gr. 1 through 6) is \$80 per child, and the fee for the evening program (Gr. 7 through 12) is \$50 per child.



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When should my child arrive during the week of the program?

The day program participants should be dropped off at the church hall at 8:45 am on the first day, and at 8:55 am on every subsequent day. Please arrange to pick up your child from the church hall at 2:30 pm.

The evening program participants should be dropped off at the church hall at 5:50 pm and be picked up by 9:00 pm.

What should my child bring to the program in terms of food and clothing?

Children attending the day program (Gr. 1 to 6) are asked to bring their own bagged lunch, snacks, and drinks, as well as appropriate clothing for both indoor and outdoor activities. On the afternoon of Fri. July 19, the day program kids will participate in a “water fight,” so please make sure to wear appropriate attire. Equipment to facilitate the event will be provided, although feel free to bring your own water guns, if you wish.

There is no requirement to bring a meal for the evening program (Gr. 7 to 12). Dinner will be provided by the parish. On Thurs. July 18, the evening program will conclude with a messy outdoor event, such that participants are advised to bring extra clothes and a towel.

Due to allergies, please note that the parish will be a nut and seafood free zone for the duration of the program.

What kind of opportunities are available to assist with the program?

If you are interested in volunteering, you will need to complete a volunteer form and undergo screening.

Supervising and Assisting with Classes

We will require both adult and student volunteers (min. high school level) who can supervise the students; and assist with classes, where needed.

Hosting Lay Missionaries

Host families will accommodate our lay missionaries from the evening of Sun. July 14 through Fri. July 19. Host families are responsible for giving the lay missionaries a light breakfast at 7 am each day. The male and female missionaries will sleep at separate homes, but the two men or the two women cannot be split up.

Providing Lunch for Lay Missionaries and Volunteers

We will require parish families to assist in providing lunch for the lay missionaries and volunteers during the course of the week. Ideally, we will have a different parish family for each day.

Potluck Dinner

Volunteers can also bring food to the potluck dinner on Thurs. July 18 (5:00 pm to 6:30 pm).
